Our Facilities

Whangarei Branch

Our purpose-built architecturally designed facility is equipped with the latest audiovisual equipment, modern reception lounge with catering facilities. We have three private arrangement rooms, two private viewing rooms, a modern mortuary facility, a main chapel and a family chapel. Our premises can be easily accessed from either 199 Kamo Road or 17 Western Hills Drive.



Chapels & Lounges

We offer 2 non-denominational chapels and 1 reception lounge with full AV equipment and live streaming services for those who can't be there in person. Our main chapel seats around 260 people and has three drop down screens with projectors for DVD and PowerPoint presentations, large screen TV's in the foyer and lounge plus an outside screen to cater for the larger funerals.
